Actions agreed:

Ladies Section

As part of the developmental pathway to help the Ladies understand how to play in team games, we are planning on running a 3 month internal league consisting of 3 teams of 5 players.

We'd like to play those matches in the evenings so the girls get a true experience of what team matches involve.

We need one evening a month where we can book 2 courts from 7-9pm? – agreed and courts booked PR agreed there were no team matches on Mondays so we could book these out

Rob Lelliot from Surrey Racketball wants to have a Surrey Ladies Racketball League running in 2/3 years and we would love to have a team ready to represent Woking.

It was agreed that Monday evenings could be used for future team matches for ladies for either racketball or Squash if we get a team

The girls themselves have shown great interest in these team games and we instantly had lots of girls put their names forward wanting to be included which is really positive.

Some of them are really ready for the next step and a couple have said they want to join the main racketball league now :)

We 've also booked courts for the ladies general RB club night – Tue 17th sept, Mon 14th Oct, Mon 18th Nov, Fri 6th Dec for our Xmas club night and social. All dates agreed with PR. We could cancel a couple of courts if necessary

We had some ladies that did not renew in April due to injuries or work commitments. We are aiming to advertise our Friday sessions on the Horsell Wire, Nextdoor.com, Facebook etc to increase the numbers.

We're also hoping to advertise and work with Pure Gym (meeting arranged for Tue 17th Sept - JT)

Sukhy has just paid for and undergone her level 2 coaching course and I'm aiming to do the same at the end of this year / early next year so that we can both continue to support the lady members at the club.

JT to see tom at Pure Gym(meeting arranged for Tue 17th Sept)

Are off-peak ladies allowed to play in the club night games? - Yes but Not in the main leagues

Juniors

AB has dates for the upcoming term of coaching from Rob and also for an October half term camp. These have been emailed to the membership.

Members suggestion:

Have a themed night once per month on Thursdays (e.g. wine & cheese night) to encourage people to hang around a bit more. I know there's a core group that often stay for food after club night but this doesn't normally kick off until after midnight 2. Hold raffles for tickets to nearby UK tournaments (Channel VAS, Canary Wharf etc) 3. Cleaning – we're in the process of starting new, hopefully having a deep clean next weekend after the maintenance work and continuing from there. Haven't signed any contracts yet though.

Annual pat test - JC to speak to electrician to schedule next test. Alan been today. He will fit heating cassettes – we need to get them though. JC to get quote – all work being completed this week

Maintenance officer to take ownership of tasks

- Get 2 new small board for upstairs (like the ones downstairs) Juniors & Ladies AB. Cork boards on the stairs completed. Put Ladies board nearest to changing rooms
- Come up with an annual maintenance list. Believe this to take a year to do i.e. gutters, hedges, court maintenance, pat testing, fire ex service, boiler service
- Doorbell future thought, the one with a video screen JB research or move upstairs asked Index security - £1256 plus vat inc video monitor, lock release. JC can ask electrician – asked today and is quoting. Work being carried out this week. JB to sort
- JB updating first aid kit done
- Emails to members to stop parking in the entrance SP newsletter
- What is the root cause of the door keep failing? JC to ask electrician to investigate
- The weeds need clearing in the car park and front of the club. CS
- Fix the clock to the wall in the men's changing room and fill the gap in the floor in the toilet. CS
- The computer by the bar keeps crashing. Needs a rebuild or maybe replaced. JF
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Court Maintenance

The court maintenance is obviously in progress - we are replacing the floor on court 1 and also the overhead lights on court 1 are being replaced with LED units. I suggest that we also fit long-wave cassette heaters on this court before winter.

I am still to hear back from David regarding the insulation measurements - I will chase this.

Bar

JC has done a spreadsheet re increased bar prices. Ensure no loss on anything. JC to increase prices slightly as agreed asap - completed

Lease

We have 22 years left on out lease so unlikely to be renewed

Affiliation fees – Affiliation fees have been paid, the county charge was actually advertised at last year's SSRA AGM. I have looked through this year's SSRA AGM agenda and it does not look like they are planning to increase it.

Sponsorship and teams:

JB has made a lot of progress with GGR and it looks like they will be prepared to sponsor the club again. We held a meeting with Paul Reilly and Adrian and Ryan, who also agreed to contribute to first team sponsorship. Paul has agreed that the first team will contribute back to the club with appearances at the world squash day and some junior coaching. He has also agreed to send write-ups of all 1st team matches for us to publish on Facebook. I need to write up and send out the minutes from that meeting.

SP also spoke to a reporter from Woking News and Mail last week; he is going to write a piece on the club and they are also interested in publishing match reports.
